• Communicate, educate, and share on-the-ground challenges and successes experienced by private landowners with our state and national leaders and agency decision-makers.

• Support voluntary, incentivebased programs that are flexible, predictable, and emphasize the value of people and partnership, and have measurable outcomes

• Transfer experiences, expertise, and lessons learned about cooperative conservation and holistic land management tools, funding, and technical resources

• Increase and leverage funding for efforts that promote cooperative conservation

• Support local, watershed, and/or place-based conservation efforts by providing an umbrella group to effect change at the regional and national conservation scale

• **Promote the 80-20 rule for conservation:** Work the 80% held in common, instead of the 20% that divides
